Martin Schüller, Development Policies Manager, TransFair e.V. studied Agriculture at the University of Giessen with a focus on environmental protection and rural development.

He started his career in an engineering office for environmental impact assessment and landscape planning before he changed his professional field to development aid and co-operation. From 1998 to 2008 he worked for the German Development Service (DED, Deutscher Entwicklungsdienst) as development worker and project manager in different countries in Africa and South America. Between 2008 and 2010 he was responsible for the and for the rural development program of the Church Development

Service (eed, Evangelischer Entwicklungsdienst).

Since 2010 Martin Schüller works for TransFair e.V. as Development Policy Manager. In his position he represents the development policy positions in national and international boards. Moreover he is responsible for the dialog and co-operation with organisations acting in the field of development aid and fair trade.
